



## **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT**

MHTN is committed to providing and maintaining a healthy and safe working environment for all its associates, course participants and any other people who may be affected by its activities.

This statement applies to all premises and activities within the control of MHTN.

In order to achieve this aim MHTN has the following key objectives:

- as a minimum, to comply with requirements of relevant legislation;
- to identify hazards (the potential for harm), assess risks (the likelihood of that harm being realised) and manage those risks;
- to ensure that associates, course participants and others are adequately informed of the identified risks and where appropriate receive instruction, training and supervision;
- to make arrangements for co-ordination and co-operation with other organisations where:
- associates and course participants share premises, facilities or activities with persons working in other organisations;
- persons from other organisations are working in MHTN controlled activities;
- to monitor and review the effectiveness of MHTN's arrangements and where appropriate to implement improvements.
- to ensure that the demands of activities do not exceed the capabilities of MHTN Associates and course participants to carry out the activities without risk to themselves or others.

MHTN will actively monitor the management of risks under their control and the implementation of safety action plans.

Whilst MHTN accepts the main responsibility for implementation of this policy individuals have an important role in co-operating with those responsible to ensure a healthy and safe working environment. Individuals are required to abide by rules and requirements made under the authority of this policy
